During lockdown, we will be using Google Classroom to set work for the children.

Reception, Y1 and Y2

For children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, parents will need to set Google Classroom up on a suitable device – a phone, tablet or laptop. Please go to the school website https://hurleyschool.co.uk/ and click on the parent tab, followed by home learning to find a video and pdf on how to access Google Classroom.

Year 3-6

Children in Year 3-6 have already had the opportunity to complete home learning on Google Classroom but you can also check the above link for a reminder.

Work

Children will be set daily activities which they will be expected to complete. Your child's class teacher will be in touch about how this home learning will work within your child's year group. Teachers will put work on to Google classroom each day by no later than 9am (although this may be put on earlier). Children (with appropriate support from parents) must hand in work when it is completed and by the end of the school day at 3pm – this should be done using Google Classroom. Daily Contact

All children will be expected to take part in a video meeting, on Google Classroom, at least once a day:

- Year 6 will meet at 9am
- Year 5 at 9.15
- Year 4 at 9.30
- Year 3 at 9.45
- Year 2 at 10am
- Year 1 at 10.15
- Reception at 10.30

The purpose of these meetings will to be to explain the day's learning and check on children's progress. Absence from these meetings will be noted and we will contact the parents of children who are not engaged in home learning offer further support.

Class teachers and Mr Hardman will remain available to support you with home learning where at all possible.

Virtual Teaching

There may be times when teachers need to teach part/the whole of a lesson – children will need to log on at the appropriate time to watch this lesson. This will not be a daily occurrence for many year groups. However, support groups involving smaller groups of children may still occur for children needing additional support.

Internet-Ready Devices

If you need to borrow internet-ready devices for home learning, we have some devices available. Please contact Mr Hardman urgently at hardman.m@welearn365.com and he will discuss possible options to support your child/ren.

If at any point you are struggling, please contact your child's class teacher and we will try to help you as swiftly as possible. Please also bear with us during this time – technical issues are bound to occur, and this is a learning process for all!
