

HURLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM UPDATED 2022



Please read the new requirements for school uniform from September.

We are proud of our school uniform and all children are expected to wear it and take a pride in their appearance. If parents have difficulty in providing this, the Headteacher must be informed.

GIRLS

White polo shirt or blouse

Navy sweatshirt/jumper or cardigan

Grey or **black** skirt- no more than 2" above/below the knee

Grey or **black** trousers – NO LEGGINGS

Plain grey, black or **white** socks and **grey** or **black** tights

In the summer, children may choose to wear:

Blue school summer dress

Grey or **black** shorts

BOYS

White polo shirt or shirt

Navy sweatshirt/jumper

Grey or **black** trousers

Grey or **black** socks

In the summer, children may choose to wear:

Grey or **black** shorts

Footwear

Only sensible **smart, black flat shoes** (no heels, trainers or boots) should be worn. There are a large number of black trainers available, but these do not meet our uniform expectations. If you are unsure, please check with the Headteacher.

School Logo Uniform

Coats, sweatshirts, cardigans, t shirts and polo shirts with the school logo are available from school. Order forms are available from the school office.

From September 2022

Children are to come into school in their PE kits on PE days. Your child's class teacher will inform you of their PE days at the start of the new term. Please ensure you child wears the correct PE kit to school.

For PE:

- **Plain white** t-shirt or Hurley logo t-shirt
- **Plain black** sports shorts or cycling shorts (no branded wear)
- **Plain black** joggers (no branded wear)
- Pair of trainers

On PE days, children are to wear their school sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan and in winter, wear their black joggers to keep warm.

In the cooler weather, if your child is doing gym, they must wear shorts underneath their joggers as they will need shorts for their lesson.

If your child is swimming, they must wear their normal school uniform that day, not their PE kits.

Swimming Kit

- Girls **MUST** wear a one-piece swimming costume (not bikinis). Boys **MUST** wear swimming trunks or shorts, but not below the knee.
- Swimming hats **MUST** be worn by all children with long hair. Children may wear goggles.
- For safety reasons, we expect children to remove stud earrings and watches before PE lessons. It is preferable that they are left at home on P.E. days. No earrings are allowed in the swimming pool.

Jewellery

If ears are recently pierced, only small discreet studs are allowed. These should be removed by the pupil before games and PE lessons. If not removed by the pupil, he/she will be expected to apply plasters, micropore tape. This is for your child's safety. Nose studs and other body piercings are not acceptable.

Watches can be worn but children remain responsible for these.

Make-up and nail varnish are not suitable for school days.

Hairstyles

Shaved heads/shaved patterns/dyed hair or other inappropriate hairstyles are not allowed. If you are unsure, please contact the Headteacher before making the decision.

All hair of a substantial length should be tied back during the school day. Only simple, plain headbands can be worn. A small navy bow is acceptable, but larger bows are not part of the school uniform.

We do hope that ALL parents will continue to support us with these uniform requirements. If children wear the incorrect uniform and the school has not been informed, we will contact parents to discuss any issues.
