ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY FACTS

Education is compulsory from the first day of the term following a child's 5th birthday.

Regular attendance is a legal requirement

- Children go to school for 12 years including Reception = 2340 days
- One day per week absence = 468 days lost (2.4 YEARS of school)
- Two weeks holiday per year = 168 days lost (2.5 TERMS of school)

Punctuality is also legal requirement

- 5 minutes lateness per day = 1 WHOLE TERM lost
- 15 minutes average lateness per day = 1 WHOLE YEAR lost
