Well Done - A huge well done to our fabulous Year 6 children who have recently finished their SATs! They were amazing, super focused and tried their very best. We are so proud of each and every one of them.

Family Learning – Our family learning sessions for KS2 (Year 3,4, 5 & 6) children and their parents begin after half term. There are still some places left so please contact the Admin Team on Dojo for a place if you are interested.

Phonics and Times Table Checks – Next half term, Year 1 have the Phonics Check and Year 4 complete the Multiplication Times Table Check. Parents don't need to do anything specific other than to help our children complete any activities set or sent home by their class teachers.

Arrival at School – A reminder that school opens at 8.45am and children should be in school by no later than 8.55am. From after half term, we will be locking the gate on the playground at 8.55am and anyone arriving after this time will need to walk round to reception to register their child as late and confirm dinner choices.

Uniform – There is a slight update coming to our uniform policy for September. We will be supplying Hurley hoodies for PE days only. These will be a part of the uniform requirements for new classes joining the school but if parents wish to purchase one, they can from our new uniform supplier.

Please note that children should only have one pair of small, discrete, stud earrings in school. When they are doing PE, ideally these will be removed or covered. For health and safety reasons, no hooped earrings or rings, necklaces and bangles should be worn. Watches (not smart ones) are allowed but will be removed for PE.

Please inform your child's class teacher if your child isn't wearing the correct uniform for any reason. For children who regularly have the incorrect footwear on, we have bought some spare pumps which we lend out for the day. These will also be used as spare shoes in emergencies. Parents may receive a reminder from your child's class teacher about uniform which doesn't match the policy.

Attendance has continued to improve! We are above the national average for the year so far - well done and thank you! This only has positive outcomes for the children. Attendance below 95% and/or regular lateness have a significant impact on the education of a pupil and their achievements later in life so please ensure you child is attending school regularly. If you have any issues with school attendance, please don't hesitate to contact me.

Clubs – All school clubs will continue next half term. Clubs will finish in the penultimate week of term. Please make sure you have paid for your child's clubs. We will be contacting parents with outstanding debts.

Holiday Club – We are looking to gauge interest in a holiday club. We will only be able to run this if we get enough bookings. Please see the chat message on Dojo explaining how to express your interest!

Summer Fayre – Please join us on Saturday 28th June at 1pm for our Summer Fayre. There will be lots of fun activities, the BBQ and our raffle with loads of great prizes.
