Be Hurley Smart!

School uniform is important for creating a sense of belonging; children wearing smart uniform helps to create a sense of pride in our fabulous school. We are proud of our school uniform and all children are expected to wear it and take a pride in their appearance. If parents have difficulty in providing this, the Headteacher must be informed.



HURLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM

White polo shirt, shirt or blouse

Plain navy jumper or cardigan or Hurley logo jumper/cardigan

Grey skirt- no more than 2" above/below the knee

Grey trousers – no leggings or joggers

Plain grey, black or white socks and grey tights

In the summer, children may choose to wear: **Blue** school summer dress **Grey** shorts—must be school shorts and of a sensible length.

Footwear

Only sensible **smart**, **polishable**, **black flat shoes** (no heels, trainers, boots or light-up shoes) should be worn. There are a large number of black trainers available, but these do not meet our uniform expectations. If you are unsure, please check with the Headteacher.

School Logo Uniform

PE Kits

Children are to come into school in their PE kits on PE days. Your child's class teacher will inform you of their PE days at the start of the new term. Please ensure you child wears the correct PE kit to school.

PE Uniform

- For **Reception 2025 starters** children need to have a **Hurley logo** hoody (no other hoody will be accepted, this is part of their PE uniform)
- Y1-6 can continue to wear their School jumper or cardigan or Hurley logo hoody (no other hoody will be accepted)
- Plain white t-shirt or Hurley logo PE t-shirt
- Plain black sports shorts or cycling shorts regular length (no branded wear)
- Plain black joggers (no branded wear)
- Pair of trainers

In the cooler weather, if your child is doing gym, they must wear shorts underneath their joggers as they will need shorts for their PE lesson.

Swimming Kit

If your child is swimming, they must wear their normal school uniform that day, not their PF kits.

Our swimming lessons take part at school in a temporary swimming pool on our playground. Lessons are conducted by a qualified swimming instructor and lifeguard to provide intensive lessons everyday for two weeks.

When your child is swimming, they will need:

- Suitable swimming costume for girls (no two pieces).
- Suitable swimming shorts for boys.
- Suitable swim top if desired.
- A towel which is big enough to fully wrap around your child or one that goes over their head.
- Googles if desired.
- Swimming hat if desired (can be purchased via our School Office).
- Crocs or sliders to wear on their feet to walk across the playground.
- Optional dressing gown to wear (otherwise, large towel will be sufficient).
- Strong bag to carry items and one to put wet swimwear and towels into.
- ALL ITEMS MUST BE NAMED.

Jewellery and make-up

- Only **one pair of small discreet studs** are allowed.
- For your child's safety, on days that they have PE, including swimming, earrings need to be removed and left at home. If ears are recently pierced and earrings cannot be removed for a period of 6 weeks, the pupil will be expected to apply plasters or micropore tape.
- Nose studs and other body piercings are not acceptable.
- Watches can be worn but children remain responsible for these. No smart watches please.
- Make-up and nail varnish are not suitable for school days.

Hairstyles

Shaved heads/shaved patterns/dyed hair or other inappropriate hairstyles are not allowed. If you are unsure, please contact the Headteacher before making the decision.

All hair of a substantial length should be tied back during the school day. Only **simple**, **plain headbands** can be worn. A **small navy bow** is acceptable, but larger bows and claw clips are not part of the school uniform.

Please make sure all of your child's school sweatshirts/cardigans and outerwear are clearly labelled with your child's name.

We do hope that ALL parents will continue to support us with these uniform requirements. If children wear the incorrect uniform and the school has not been informed, we will contact parents to discuss any issues.
