



ROMAN BRITAIN Y4 Knowledge Organiser



Key Dates	
43 AD to 410 AD	The Romans remained in Britain. This is almost four hundred years!
61 AD	Come British tribes revolt, led by Boudicca, but they are defeated in battle.
78 AD	The Roman complete the conquering of Wales.
122 AD	Emperor Hadrian orders the building of Hadrian's wall.

Important People
<p>Caesar (100—44BC)</p> <p>In 55BC Caesar, with 80 ships and 80,000 men, tried to invade England but he didn't succeed. The next year he came back with 800 and again he didn't success to conquer South-England.</p>
<p>Claudius (AD 10—54)</p> <p>Claudius was the emperor who conquered Britain.</p>
