



Topic: This half term, our History focus is the Romans. Within this unit, we will look at different sources to understand the structure of the Roman empire and how the Roman invasion impacted Britain. We will be going on a trip to Lunt Fort in Coventry to learn all about Roman soldiers. This trip is booked for the first week back in Summer 1 half term.

PE: This half term, PE lessons will be on **Thursdays (Gym)** and **Fridays (PE)**.

Music: Children will be starting cornet lessons once a week with an external music teacher.

Homework: English or Maths homework will be sent out on a **Friday** and is due back in no later than the following **Friday**. Children will receive:

- 3 Dojos if homework is given in on a Monday
- 2 Dojos if homework is given in on a Tuesday
- 1 Dojo if homework is given in on any other day



1 Soundcheck on TTRS is also part of children's weekly homework. If they complete this, they will earn an extra 10 minutes of play time on a Friday.

Reading: Diaries are checked every Thursday. Children must read 3 times a week for 10 weeks to receive each reading award.

MTC: The Multiplication Tables Check will take place in June. TTRS recommend a "little and often" approach; 3 minutes practice a day, 4 or 5 times a week is a good target.



Spellings: Children have some time in school to practise their spellings but it is also essential they practise their spellings at home. EdShed logins are stuck inside the cover of their diaries. Spelling tests take place every Thursday.
