PE days will be **Mondays and Fridays**. Please send children into school in their PE kits following the uniform expectations.



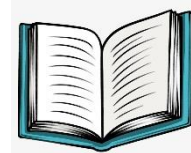
Uniform reminders

- If ears are recently pierced, only **small discreet studs** are allowed. These should be removed by the pupil before games and PE lessons. If not removed by the pupil, he/she will be expected to apply micropore tape. This is for your child's safety.
- School shoes need to be worn on non-PE days. If children are wearing trainers on other days, they will be swapped into pumps.
- A reminder that **all hair of a substantial length should be tied back** during the school day.
- Please ensure that all items of uniform are clearly named.



Reading books/Diaries

Please ensure that reading books and diaries are sent into school every day. These are needed in school as spellings are stuck in weekly and staff write in them when pupils are read with.



Diaries will be regularly checked to see if children have read at home.

If you have written a message in your child's diary, please mention this to someone at the door so that we can ensure the diary is checked that day.

Spellings and maths checks

Spelling and maths checks will continue to be done on **Fridays** (the first test will be on 17th April). Books are now being kept in school unless children would like to take them home. The weekly focus for the maths checks is shared on Class Dojo. Please note that sometimes we stay on the same topic for more than 2 weeks.

Please continue to use TTRS for practicing tables. It will really help pupils as they go up to the Juniors. Children also have Spelling Shed logins. An assignment is set weekly for children to practise the spellings for the week. Dojos are always on offer whenever we see children have logged in!
