Lunch boxes go onto the trolley by your peg. We put our lunch boxes on the bottom shelf.

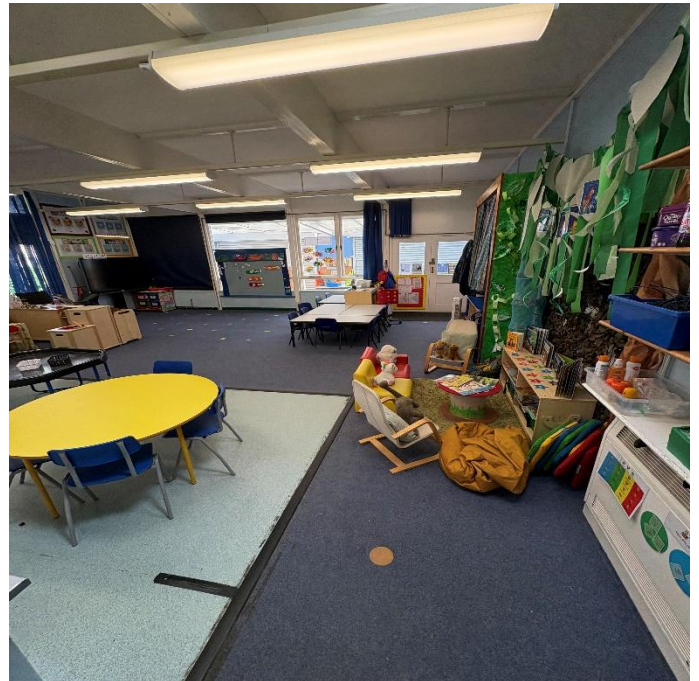
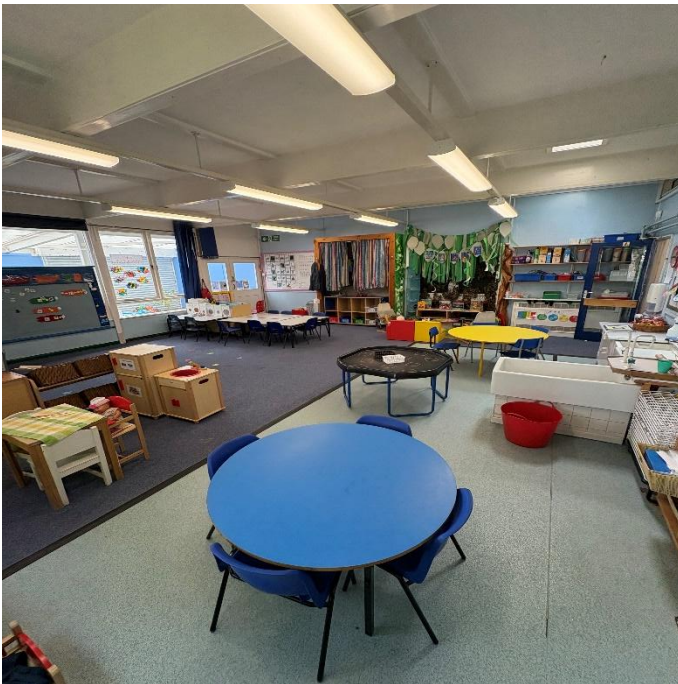


Your book bag goes on the colour shelves. You put them on the shelf that matches your house colour. The colour is on the name card of you book bag.

Learning Environment – Classroom



In the classroom there are plenty of areas to explore. When starting in Reception, you are given a space to sit on the carpet.



The classroom has lots of different places for learning and trying new things. We have a reading corner, art table, role play zone, writing table, playdough station as well as other toys and resources you can use when you have choosing time.

Learning Environment – Veranda



In the covered veranda we have so much you can do. There is a sand pit for digging and building in.



We also have lots of different construction materials such as wooden blocks, stickle bricks and duplo. There are lots of small world toys too - house, cars and a train table.



We have a wonderful learning lodge just outside the veranda where some of your learning will take place.

You might even do some 1-1 work with the teacher in Reception to help you.

Learning Environment – Side Garden



In our side garden we have lots of exciting things to do.



We have an exploring zone where you can build and create using the different materials.



We have a mud kitchen where you can make lots of yummy, tasty and messy treats.



We also have a tepee for calm and quiet reading, a stage for singing and dancing and a climbing obstacle course.
